

**Town of Felton
Town Council Meeting
November 4, 2013
6:30 pm**

Mayor Kelley called the Town Council Meeting of Felton to order at 6:30 pm on Monday, November 4, 2013. Present at the meeting were:

Council Members: Mayor Dave Kelley, Vice-Mayor Joe Yapsuga, Kevin Fletcher, Joanne Clendaniel and Anthony Carroll.

Staff: Town Manager, Rebecca Greene; Chief, Levi Brown and Town Clerk, Amy Lupinetti.

Public: Resident - William Brittingham.

Citizens Concerns:

There were no citizens concerns.

Police Report:

Rebecca presented the October 2013 Police Report.

Rebecca stated that Levi had to go out to a complaint and will return. She stated that the numbers are down due to extreme amounts of rain and also officers have been in conferences in October.

Mayor Kelley asked what the other income in the amount of \$95 is and Rebecca replied that it is the Police Reports income and also payroll reimbursement from Frederica. Rebecca stated that Frederica has requested that we have one of our officers present at their Council Meetings. Mayor Kelley stated that he does not think that it is a good idea to have one of our officers at their meetings and he will call the Mayor and talk to him.

Chief Brown returned to the Council Meeting and Mayor Kelley asked him why Frederica wants one of our officers at the meetings. Levi stated that there is a gentleman at the meetings that their Council Members are having an ongoing battle with and we provide them with one of our officers for two hours.

Motion: Councilman Fletcher made a motion to accept the October 2013 Police Report. Vice-Mayor Yapsuga seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

Budget Report:

Rebecca stated that the interest for the bank accounts is missing off the reports. We have not received all of the statements and those amounts will just increase revenue.

Motion: Councilman Fletcher made a motion to accept the Budget Report. Councilman Carroll seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

Minutes:

Town Council Meeting Minutes:

Mayor Kelley presented the October 21, 2013 Town Council Meeting Minutes asking if there were any questions.

Vice-Mayor Yapsuga asked if we have ordered the speed bumps and Rebecca replied yes we just received them and we are waiting for additional ones.

Councilman Fletcher stated that someone approached him and stated there are no speed limit signs at the entrance of Hidden Pond. Rebecca stated that she would have Ralph check on that.

Motion: Vice-Mayor Fletcher made a motion to accept the October 21, 2013 Town Council Meeting Minutes. Councilman Carroll seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

Revision Process for Police Directives:

Rebecca stated that the Police Directives have not been revised in a long time. Levi thinks the revision process will be done by July. Amy will be coordinating them and we will be starting this when Levi gets back from vacation. Levi will review one section at a time, then he will give them to Amy to redline, Rebecca will review them and then submit them to the attorney.

Discussion of Ordinance Article 1 Title 8 Regulating the Parking of Oversized Vehicles:

Rebecca asked Council what the plan is for the Oversized Vehicle Ordinance. Councilwoman Clendaniel asked Council what has changed since a couple months ago when she was trying to get the Ordinance revised.

Vice-Mayor Yapsuga apologized to Joanne and stated that he did not take the time to see what the problem was with Cushman. I really didn't appreciate Mr. Mynatt saying that we didn't know what we were talking about at the Council Meeting a couple months ago.

Councilman Fletcher stated that he doesn't think that Cushman was parking his truck at his house as often as the utility truck is parked on Green Court. Councilwoman Clendaniel stated since Cushman is on the road months at a time his truck is not parked at his residence often but the guy on Green Court comes home every evening. She stated that she really didn't feel like she was being taken very seriously. Mayor Kelley apologized to Councilwoman Clendaniel and stated that he wished that she would have told Council that she didn't feel like she was being taken seriously.

Mayor Kelley stated that he would rather have the oversized vehicle in the street than in the driveway or in the yard but he has a really hard time telling people they cannot park an oversized vehicle on the street. Councilwoman Clendaniel stated that they can park it on the street they would just need to get a permit from Town Hall. Chief Brown agreed with Mayor Kelley and asked if someone has a friend coming into Town driving an 18 wheeler passing through they would have to park their truck elsewhere and Rebecca responded they could park it at Uncle Willies and have someone pick them up from there.

Mr. Brittingham joined the Council Meeting and Councilman Fletcher asked him if he had any questions. Mr. Brittingham stated he saw the agenda with this issue and just wanted to see if it pertained to him. Councilwoman Fletcher asked him if he parked his trucks in the street and Mr. Brittingham replied that he does not. Councilman Fletcher told him that he was okay and asked him as a business owners point of view how he felt if we eliminated no parking of oversized vehicles on the streets. Mr. Brittingham stated that he wouldn't feel comfortable leaving his trucks at a truck stop. It's very convenient in the morning for my trucks to be at my residence.

Councilman Carroll asked if there were certain streets they can place the oversized vehicle signs and Councilwoman Clendaniel stated that they had them on Kerry Circle before and they had to be removed since the signs were only on Kerry Circle and no other streets through Town.

Motion: Vice-Mayor Yapsuga made a motion to change Article 1 Title 8 to not allow any exceptions to no oversized vehicles parked in Town unless they get a permit. Councilman Clendaniel seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously. Roll call was taken: Mayor Kelley-no; Vice-Mayor Yapsuga -yes; Council Member Clendaniel – yes; Councilman Carroll – no and Councilman Fletcher –yes

Motion: Vice-Mayor Yapsuga made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:31pm. Councilman Carroll seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
