General Up-Dates

- Trash pick-up the week of December 24th will be on Thursday, due to the holiday on Tuesday.
- Delinquent tax statements will be mailed the second week of October.
- If you see a violation in the Town please make sure when you call Town Hall that you have the proper address.
- Town Hall hours are Monday thru Friday, 9:00am to 5:00pm.

Public Works Up-Dates

- Please welcome Josh Smith as the newest town employee. Josh is the new part-time Public Works Technician.
- If you suspect a water leak or have excessive water on your property, please contact Town Hall immediately, so it can be investigated.
- Please make sure that your trash cans are taken from the curb by the next morning after the trash has been removed.
- The renovation of Jefferson Street is under way and will continue until the middle of December. Please avoid parking and traveling on this street as much as possible.
- Lead and Copper results have been received and all samples were within the guidelines. Lead and Copper is tested every three years. Thank you to all the residents who assisted with getting samples for the testing.

Police Up-Dates

• Skateboarding is not allowed in the Town of Felton. Anyone who is caught skateboarding will have their boards taken and a parent will have to come to the Police Department to pick up the skateboard.

- School is in session so please be aware of children in the area while you are driving.
- All passengers in a vehicle need to be in seat belts or child restraints.
- Parking on sidewalks is not allowed and is a fineable offense.
- Make sure you secure all items you have outside, including grills, bicycles, etc.
- Children under the age of 18 are required to wear a helmet at all times while on a bicycle.
- Please keep your doors locked at all times.
- Secure your vehicles, even in your driveway.
- Please report any suspicious activity to 911. They will contact the Felton Police Department. It is best to call and report the activity while it is occurring.

Utility Bills will be mailed out the first week of October. The bills will be due on November 10th. If the bill is not paid by the 10th of November, a \$25 late fee will be applied to the account. A delinquent letter will be sent out with a disconnect date on the letter, if the bill is not paid by the disconnect date on the letter an additional \$50 disconnect/reconnect fee will be added to the bill and the water will be shut off until payment has been made in full.
