Halloween – October 2020

- Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic the Town will not be participating in Halloween activities this year.
- Trick or Treating in the Town will be from 6pm-8pm and we ask that everyone that participates adhere to the COVID-19 guidelines provided by The Department of Public Health. A copy of these guidelines can be picked up from Town Hall or reviewed on the Town website – felton.delaware.gov.

General Up-Dates

- Utility bills can be paid online at our website felton.delaware.gov, US Mail or placed in the drop box at Town Hall. If bills are not paid by the due date there will be a \$25 late fee applied to the account and a delinquent letter will be mailed out stating the disconnection date. If water is disconnected there will be a \$25 disconnection and a \$25 reconnection fee applied to the account. Please call Town Hall if you are unable to make payment and to set up a payment plan.
- Town Hall hours are Monday thru Friday, 8:00am to 4:00pm.
- There will be a Council Election in March of 2021.

Public Works Up-Dates

- Please make sure that your trash cans are taken from the curb by the next morning after the trash has been removed.
- Snow season is right around the corner. There may be snow residue left in front of your driveway after the streets are plowed but we try to keep this at a minimal. We appreciate everyone's understanding that the PW department is prohibited from clearing off private driveways.
- Please remember that grass clippings are not to be blown/placed on the street or in the catch basins. The grass will go into the catch basins and cause a problem with the water flow through Town.

Police Up-Dates

- All passengers in a vehicle need to be in seat belts or child restraints.
- Parking the opposite way of traffic is not allowed and is a fineable offense.
- Secure your vehicles, even in your driveway.
- If you go away and would like your property checked daily by the Police Department come into Town Hall or go to the Town's website and fill out a Property Check Form.
- Please report any suspicious activity to 911. They will contact the Felton Police Department. It is best to call and report the activity while it is occurring.

Delinquent Tax Statements will be mailed out in October. If the taxes on a property are delinquent for two years and the owner has not made payment arrangements with the Town, we will begin the process of a Sheriff Sale. The minimal fee for this is \$1,500 and will be added to the balance owed to the Town.
