Parade Rules:

1. All entries must be decorated for the holiday season. No exceptions.
2. Santa Claus / Mrs. Claus suits or actors are **NOT PERMITTED**. Santa will be the last entry in the parade riding Felton Community Fire Company truck sponsored by Odd Fellows. After the parade Santa will be at Odd Fellows Park for pictures.
3. If you are planning on handing out candy during the parade, we request that it is directly handed to the spectators by a walker from your group. **THROWING CANDY IS NOT PERMITTED**. If you are caught throwing candy you will not be able to participate in other town functions in the future. This is for safety of the spectators. If this rule is broken, we will have to eliminate the candy from parades for the years to come.
4. Any group with children under the age of 18 must have a chaperone for the group.
5. Please identify your group with a sign or banner.
6. The route is approximately 1.6 miles walking groups must be able to walk the entire route.
7. No smoking or alcoholic beverages are not allowed on any parade entry at any time.
8. No stopping at the end of the parade. You may pull in to the back of North Elementary to break down floats. If you do not need to break down a float, please proceed down East Street to keep the traffic flowing.
9. Please make sure you arrive and are parked in your designated spot prior to the start of the parade which is 7pm.
10. If your group has horses, you must have someone follow you and pick up all horse droppings. Please make sure that the horses that are in the parade can be around loud noises we cannot guarantee lineup spot.

Emails will be mailed to the person who registered the week before the parade to give you a designated group number to which you will line up with. As well as a detailed map of line up and parade route. Parade route will be down Main Street and turning onto East Street which is next to North Elementary (same route as last year).
