

ARTICLE IV

Title 25

AN ORDINANCE: PROHIBITING THE RAISING OR HARBORING OF FOWL
WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF FELTON

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Felton are vested with the responsibility of maintaining and providing for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Felton, and

WHEREAS, the breeding, harboring and raising of fowl within the limits of the Town of Felton is detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Felton,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Commissioners of the Town of Felton:

Section 1 - It shall be unlawful for any person, group of persons, association or corporation to breed, raise or otherwise harbor or maintain any chickens, turkeys, geese, ducks, or other type of fowl at any place within the limits of the Town of Felton where said fowl are allowed to remain at large or to remain in open areas.


Section 2 - This Ordinance is not intended to prevent the keeping of birds or other household pets by residents of the Town of Felton where said pets are maintained solely within the confines of a home.

Section 3 - Any person, firm, association or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and each day that the offense continues shall be considered as a

separate offense for which a like penalty shall be imposed.




